Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the State were near normal for the week. Las Vegas reported the highest temperature of the week at 83, whereas Winnemucca reported the lowest temperature at 20 degrees. Precipitation ranged from trace amounts in Tonopah to 0.85 in Winnemucca.

Field Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 5.2 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Short, 75% Adequate, and 20% surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 10% Short, 65% Adequate, and 20% surplus. Field work occurred between storms. Alfalfa continued growing slowly, whereas winter grains were growing rapidly as day-length increases. In some areas throughout the State, cattle were moving to spring range, late calvers were over 70 percent completed.
